Sub: <u>Intimation under Regulations 30 and 51 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements)</u> Regulations, 2015 ('SEBI Listing Regulations')

This is further to our letter dated August 14, 2023, wherein we have informed the Stock Exchanges about the pending litigations of the Company which included a litigation involving Company's subsidiary Tata Chemicals Magadi Ltd (TCML) and County Government, Kajiado, Kenya arising out of dispute over demand raised by the County Government for land rates. As on March 31, 2025, the revised demand stood at ₹ 783 crore (Kenyan Shillings 11.84 billion).

We wish to inform you that the Court of Appeal, Nairobi has vide its order dated October 24, 2025 decided the case in favour of TCML and ordered that the demand raised by the County Government was arbitrary and illegal and that TCML is not obliged to pay the land revenue arrears in the absence of an open and accountable framework for determining the land rates.

The disclosures as required under Regulations 30 and 51 read with Schedule III of SEBI Listing Regulations and SEBI circular SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024 are enclosed as Annexure.

We request you to take the above on record.
