The proposed treated wastewater disposal project deals only with the industrial effluent. The project proponent shall ensure that no ground water drawal is carried out within CRZ areas without prior approval of the Central Ground Water Authority. It shall also be ensured that untreated wastewater is not discharged outside the project premises. Wastewater generated shall be treated in STP and is reused for 10 WASTE MANAGEMENT landscaping, flushing and HVAC cooling purposes. The project proponent should also make alternate arrangement for situation arising due to malfunctioning of STP. There shall be regular monitoring of the results of standard parameters of the effluent discharged from STP under intimation to the SPCB. **PPs Submission:** Complied Noted. TCL assures that ground water will not be withdrawn within CRZ areas. Untreated Date: wastewater will not be discharged outside the project premises. As explained under Para (ix) above 05/11/2025 domestic wastewater generated in the township is mainly recycled and reused within company township and surplus treated sewage is discharged into the Arabian Sea as per prescribed norms. Regular monitoring of treated sewage is conducted by the environmental laboratory of expert agency

After completion of the treated wastewater pipeline project, the corridor will be cleared of debris and left-over construction materials and restored to its original gradient.
