






FY 12 Consolidated Financial Highlights

- Board of Directors recommend dividend of ₹ 10 per share












Industry Essentials

- Global Soda Ash demand firm.
- Domestic Soda Ash demand flat due to delays in commissioning of some float glass line
- Demand for Sodium Bicarbonate in UK highest at 63 KT
- Capacity debottlenecking at TCNA added 100,000 MT
- Soda Ash and Sodium Bicarb operations stable in Mithapur
- British Salt performance robust production, sales and realisations continue to be healthy
- Cement sales crossed 500,000 MT for the first time
- TCML doubles operating margins on the back of improved efficiencies







Farm Essentials



- SSP debottleneck completed on 30th November. Average production achieved 650TPD v/s earlier 450 TPD
- Plant shut down for replacing the Ammonia converter from 30th
 March to 1st May 2012.
- Haldia operations remained slow in Q4 owing to uncertain pricing for Phos Acid.
- Formal announcement of Urea Investment policy awaited
